Sixth Sunday of Easter

Today marks the Sixth Sunday of Easter.

The First Reading is taken from the Acts of the Apostles 8:5-8, 14-17. In this reading Peter and John are sent from Jerusalem to Samaria to be ministers of the coming of the Spirit to the new converts in that town. These men had already been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus, and the imposition of hands completes the initiation of these converts. —A Celebrant's Guide to the New Sacramentary - A Cycle by Kevin W. The Second Reading is from the First Letter of Peter 3:15-18 and indicates that baptism initiates a person to imitation of the death and resurrection of Jesus and that the destiny of all believers is to live according to the realm of the Spirit. —A Celebrant's Guide to the New Sacramentary - A Cycle by Kevin W. The Gospel is from St. John 14:15-21. In this discourse at the Last Supper, which was His last will and testament, our divine Lord promised His Church, through the Apostles, that the Holy Spirit would be with it until the end of time. The Spirit of truth will be directing it and effectively aiding it to preserve the faith, the doctrine, and the morals which Christ taught His Apostles.

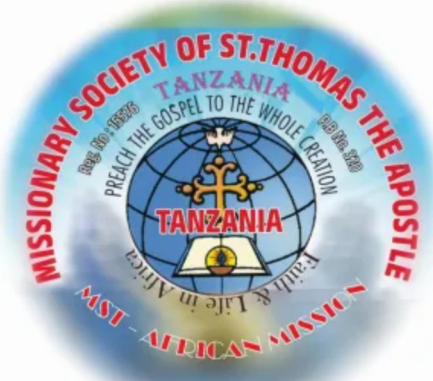

Since then, the Society has grown steadily and today has 412 missionary priests serving in different parts of the world, especially in the interior villages of India and Africa. At present, around 120 seminarians are in various stages of formation.

This year, our attention is especially directed toward the mission in Delhi, where many children live on the outskirts of the city beside vast waste dumping yards. In the midst of these difficult conditions MST seeks to bring hope and restore dignity through educational opportunities, financial literacy programs, nutritional support, and medical assistance, especially for those who suffer from chronic illnesses. Through these works of charity, we strive to make present the healing and redeeming love of Christ.
